▶ ▶ ▶ ▶ ▶ Legislative Terms

Emergency Clause: If any bill contains an emergency clause – it becomes implemented effective the moment that it is signed into law by the governor.

Effective Date: If any bill contains effective date language – it clarifies the date the law is implemented. Most Oklahoma laws passed in spring session are implemented November 1st of the same year of session.

**In the event there is no emergency clause or effective date in the bill, it is implemented 90 days after the adjournment of the spring session. Our legislative session is slated to end May 20th-May 25th, 2019. New laws with no effective date, nor emergency clause should be implemented/effective on August 26th, 2019.*
